

GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

The Computer Education Research Journal (CERJ) is the main scientific journal of the Computer Education Association of Nigeria (CEAN). CERJ publishes innovative research papers, review articles, and reports in all areas of Computing in Education, including Software developments and applications, Hardware Maintenance, Multimedia applications, Programming, E-learning/M-learning, ICT Graphic designs, Cloud computing etc. The journal's interest is particularly to encourage transmission of research findings among all with passion for the promotion of research in computer education for better instructional delivery and for self reliance.

Submission of a manuscript to CERJ for publication implies that the same work has not been previously published or is not under consideration for publication in another journal. Authors, in their cover note to the editor, have to clearly confirm that the manuscript has not been submitted to any other journal for publication. Review Article should be by invitation only. All manuscripts will be subjected to blind peer review by at least two independent referees. Those of high quality, after review, will be published.

Manuscript Preparation

The preferred format of all manuscripts is MS Word. Figures, images (in JPEG, TIFF or SFC format), illustrations and tables should be inserted in the manuscript at the positions they should appear when finally published in the final version of the manuscript. Manuscripts must be typed, double-spaced on A4 (8.5" × 11") paper size with 1 inch margins and should be arranged in the following order: Title, Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, Recommendation, and References.

Title Page

The title must be as brief as possible, comprehensive and descriptive. Each author must provide their full name (surname first followed by the initials e.g. Ibezim, NE, Okafor, PU ...) followed by their address in normal face lower case. The corresponding author of the manuscript must be marked with an asterisk. In addition the corresponding author must include telephone (mobile number, for ready contact during peer review) and e-mail address at the bottom left corner of the title page. If any of the coauthors are from different organizations, their addresses too should be mentioned and indicated using numbers after their names.

Abstract

The abstract should start on a new page after the title page and should present the reason for the study, the methodology, the main findings, and principal conclusions and should not be more than 300 words.

Keywords

3-7 keywords are to be provided by the authors separated by a 'coma'.

Introduction

This should start on a new page and should provide an adequate background of the study, avoiding a detailed literature survey or a summary of the results. Objective(s) of the study should also be clearly stated

Materials and Methods

This section should include concise details on the methodology adopted. The research design adopted, area of the study, population, sample and sampling techniques used, instruments for data collection, method of data analysis and the level of significance chosen for testing null hypotheses should be clearly stated.

Results & Discussion

All results presented in tabular or graphical form shall be described in this section. All Tables and figures must have a title and a legend to make them self-explanatory. Discussion and conclusions should contain a critical review of the results of the study with the support of relevant literature. This should end with brief conclusions.

References

References should be written using the latest edition of the APA reference style

Manuscript Submission

Manuscripts should be submitted as email attachment to the address: nace.nigeria@gmail.com Submission of manuscript should be with the understanding that the manuscript has not been previously published or concurrently under consideration for publication in any other journal. A statement to this effect should be clearly stated in the forwarding letter to the editor of CERJ

Publication charges

There are no printing, subscription or membership charges for any author. Every author within Nigeria will have to pay a nominal cost (cost towards processing, maintenance of paper in secured data storage system, databases; to meet various overhead expenses) of ₦ 8,000 for a full paper while authors outside Nigeria will have to pay a nominal cost of 120 USD (United States Dollars) for a full paper irrespective of the number of pages.

Frequency of Publication

Three issues a year. Evaluation of manuscript will be rapid.
